All of his scientific, pedagogical, and organizational activities are associated with the Ivan Franko National University of Lviv. From the University, he graduated in 1969 with honor. Here he took the postgraduate course. As a talented chief, he headed for 30 years the Department of Applied Mathematics and was a long-term dean of the Faculty of Applied Mathematics and Informatics (1996–2015). In 2001 he was awarded the title of Honored Professor of this University.

Yarema H. Savula devoted more than half a century of his life to developing Ukrainian science, creating a scientific school for mathematical and computer modeling in thermomechanics. He and his students (doctors and 15 candidates of sciences) have made a significant scientific potential consisting of 5 monographs and textbooks and more than 300 scientific papers. Everything that came out of his pen was noted for novelty and originality, caused a lively discussion, and stimulated further research in modern applied mathematics and its applications.

He fruitfully collaborated with scientists from a wide range of institutions of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, in particular, S. P. Timoshenko Institute of Mechanics, V. M. Glushkov Institute of Cybernetics of the NAS of Ukraine, Pidstryhach Institute for Applied Problems of Mechanics and Mathematics of the NAS of Ukraine and its Center of Mathematical Modelling.

Yarema Hryhorovych was a very kind, sincere, and sympathetic person, constantly supporting and promoting talented youth. His inexhaustible vitality, optimism, incredible efficiency, real genuine love for Ukraine aroused sincere respect and admiration, instilled hope and confidence in the hearts of those around him.

Sudden illness and death caught him while working. His life path is an example of faithful and conscientious serving his native land and chosen activity. Friends, colleagues, and students of Yarema Hryhorovych remember with deep gratitude his bright personality, which significantly impacted the development of Ukrainian education and science.
