1. The article file should be saved in *.doc format, Word 2003 version, the file name should be the author's surname, and the language of the article should be English. The length of the article is up to 6 pages.

2. Page field settings:

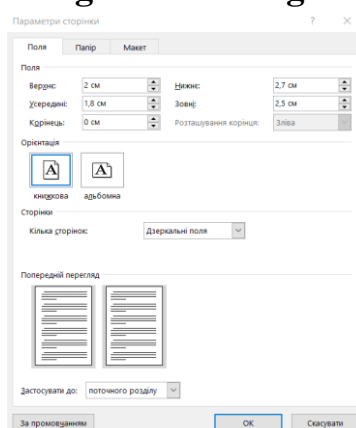


Fig.1 Page field settings

3. **The header** should follow the template (see Template_ACPS): font 12, Times New Roman, Bold, all caps, center, single line spacing

4. **Title of the article:** font 14, Times New Roman, Bold, all capital letters, center, single line spacing, spacing before and after the title - 6 pt.
5. **Surnames of the authors:** font 11, Times New Roman, Italic, Bold, center, single line spacing, spacing after the surname - 6pt.
6. **Name of the institution where the author works or studies and authors' e-mails:** font 11, Times New Roman, Italic, center, single line spacing.

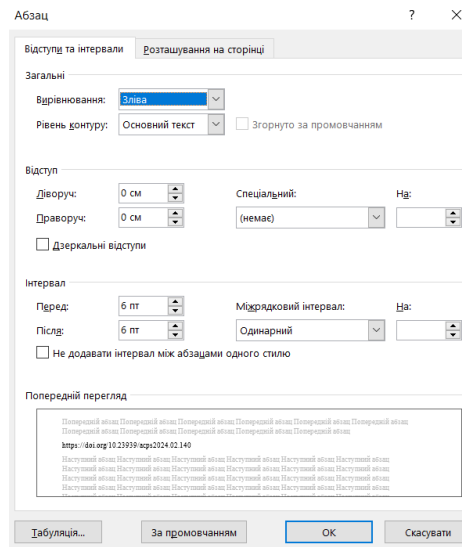


Fig. 2 Parameters of the paragraph for DOI.

7. **DOI number:** font 10, Times New Roman, left alignment, single line spacing, spacing before and after DOI - 6 pt (Fig. 2)

8. *Received, Accepted, Published* date: font 9, Times New Roman, Italic, left alignment, single line spacing, spacing before and after - 6 pt.
9. **Copyright.** (© Author F., Author S., Author Th., 2025): font 10, Times New Roman, left alignment, single line spacing, spacing after the inscription - 16 pt

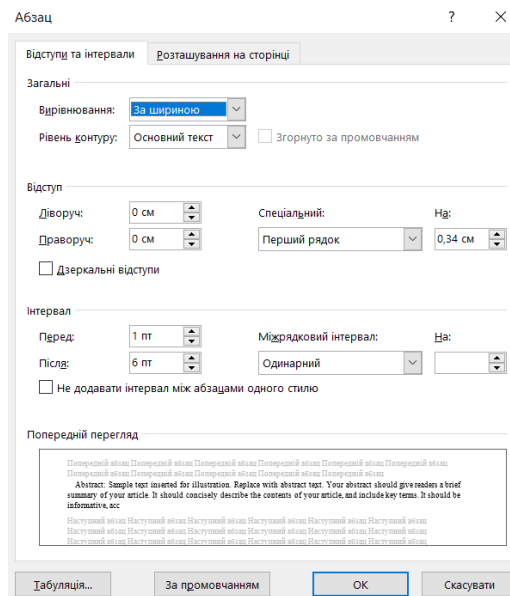


Fig.3 Paragraph parameters for abstract.

10. **Abstract:** font 9, Times New Roman, Bold, Justified alignment, paragraph formatting - as in Fig. 3:

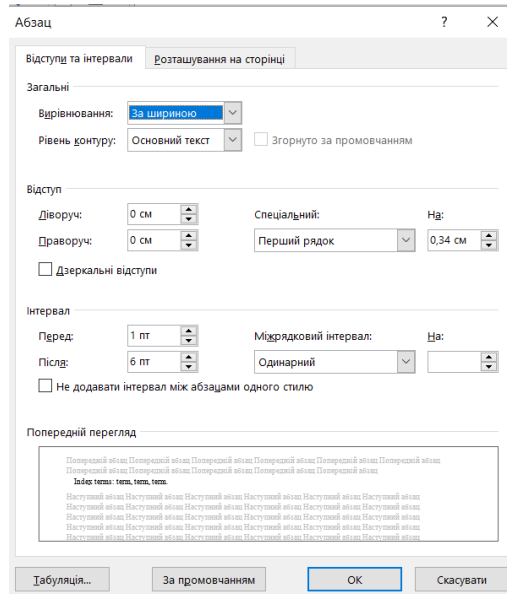


Fig.4 Paragraph settings for *Index terms*.

11. **Index terms:** font 9, Times New Roman, Bold, justified alignment, paragraph formatting - as in Fig. 4:

12. **Section titles:** font size 10, Times New Roman, all caps, numbering is in Roman numerals, paragraph formatting is as in Fig.. 5:

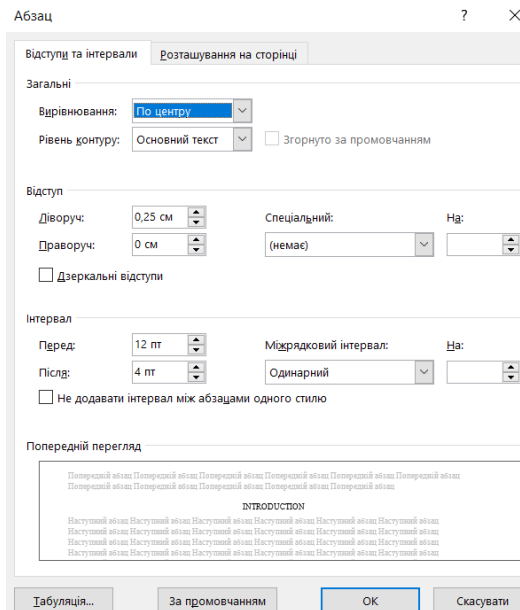


Fig. 5 Paragraph options for section titles

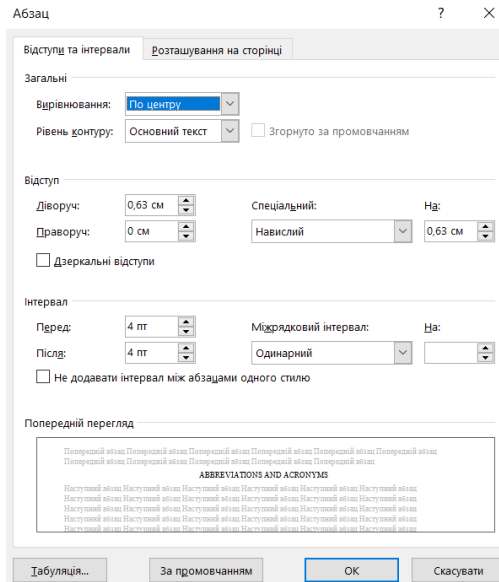


Fig. 6 Paragraph options for subsection titles

13. **Subsection titles:** font size 10, Times New Roman, all caps, numbering is in capital Latin letters, paragraph formatting is as in Fig. 6:

14. **Main text of the article:** font size 10, Times New Roman, justified alignment, single line spacing, paragraph indentation 0.75 cm. Dividing the text into two columns.

15. **Figures:** alignment - in the center, Figure caption - font 9, Times New Roman, Italic, center alignment, single line spacing, before and after figure caption - spacing 7pt. All images must be in grayscale.

16. **Tables:** table style is plain;
word *Table 1* - font 10, Times New Roman, Italic, right alignment, single line spacing, spacing before and after - 6pt.

Table name: font 10, Times New Roman, Bold, centre alignment, single line spacing, spacing 6pt before the name and 4pt after the name.

Text in the table - font 9, Times New Roman.

17. **Bullets:**

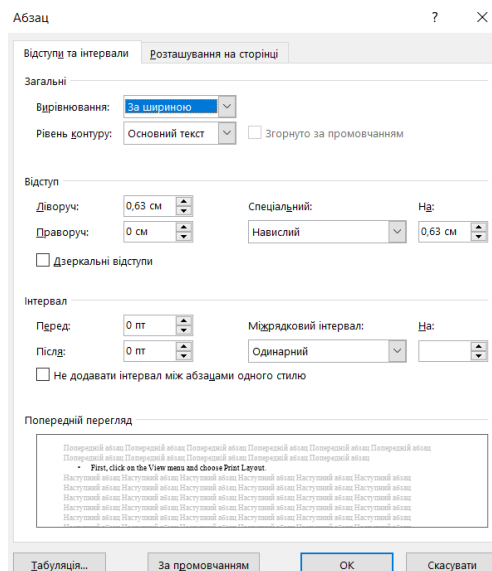


Fig. 7 Parameters of the paragraph for the bulleted list
18.Numbering:

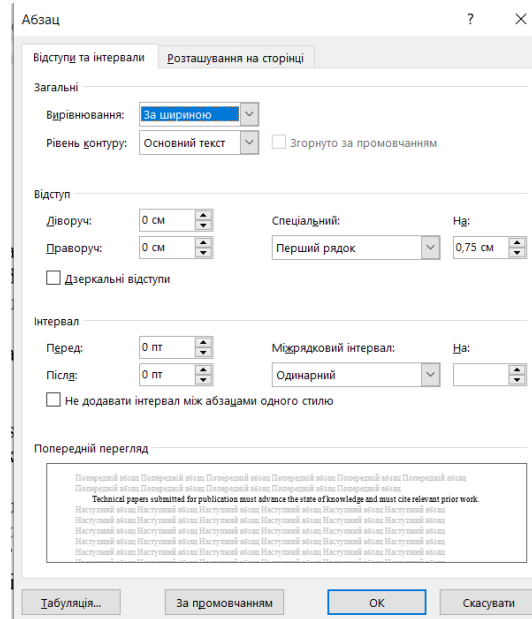


Fig. 8 Paragraph options for a numbered list

19. **Formulas** should be created in Microsoft Equation Editor or MathType. The numbering is through, on the right edge, in parentheses. The formula should be placed in the middle of the line. Paragraph formatting options are

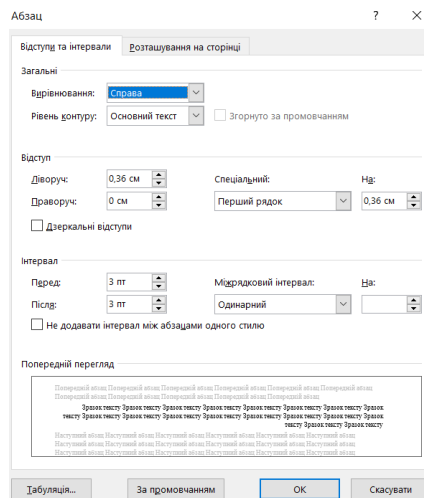
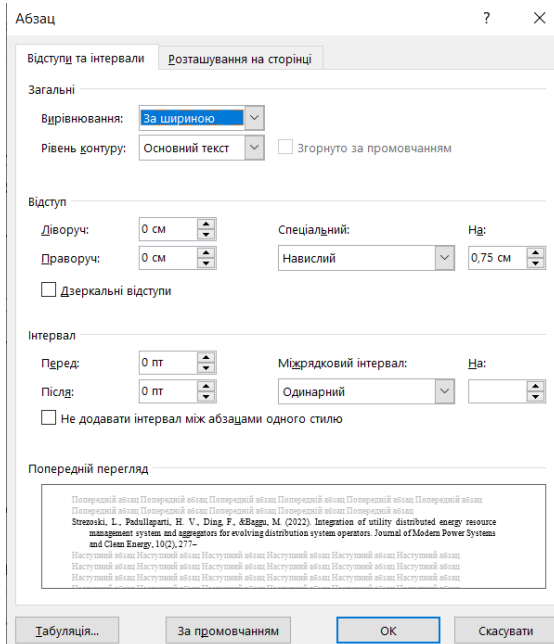


Fig. 9. Paragraph options for formulas
